English Speaking Class

授業の概要 — Course Outline

The goal of this course is to help develop basic speaking skills. This course uses themed lessons, to practice vocabulary, conversations, and teach new language items. Listening practice and improving pronunciation are important as well.

This class is taught entirely in English

到達目標 — Course Objectives

- You will examine, learn from, and practice typical model themed conversations. [汎用的技能]
- You will learn vocabulary and phrases to improve your speaking ability. [汎用的技能]
- You will practice and improve listening skills of short conversations based on daily topics, using high frequency expressions. [汎用的技能]
- You will improve conversations in repeated pair practice. [汎用的技能]
