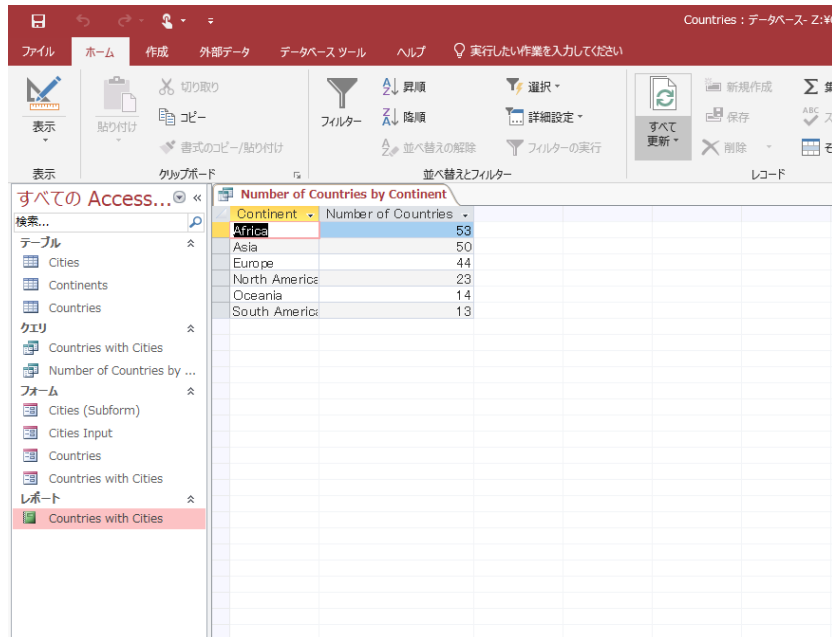


## A short introduction to Databases using Microsoft Access

### The Access Window



The sidebar of the Access window shows 4 types of objects:

- **Tables**  
This is where the data is kept. A good rule is to touch this area as little as possible.
- **Queries**  
*Query* means ‘Question’. This is where we can ask questions about the data.
- **Forms**  
This is where we browse, enter, and modify the data.
- **Reports**  
This is where we can prepare data for output.
