

The Access Window



The sidebar of the Access window shows 4 types of objects:

Tables

This is where the data is kept. A good rule is to touch this area as little as possible.

Queries

Query means 'Question'. This is where we can ask questions about the data.

Forms

This is where we browse, enter, and modify the data.

Reports

This is where we can prepare data for output.
