## **SQL Join**

In an SQL Join we take information from two tables and combine them into one table. In this example we have two tables in our "Kindergarten" database: one has the information about the students, and one has the information about the classes.

We would like to match each **student** with the **class teacher**.

In SQL we will write this as follows:

**SELECT** StudentName, ClassTeacher

FROM Students, Classes

WHERE Students.ClassID = Classes.ClassID

 $\leftarrow$  *Fields* (=*Columns*)

 $\leftarrow$  Tables

 $\leftarrow$  Condition
